NETSAFE'S ADVICE FOR PARENTS

Establish ground rules with your children when it comes to accessing the internet. This can include rules about what sites they can and can't visit and what type of apps they can have on their personal devices. Also, ensure your children understand there are consequences for not obeying these rules.

Be aware of what your children are doing online. This can include watching and reading online content with them as well as monitoring their browser history to make sure the content they are accessing is safe and secure.

Have a conversation with your children about what to do if they do come across upsetting content. **Make sure they know they should come to you** or a trusted adult straight away with any issue they have online.

Stay calm if they do come to you – don't assign blame, reassure them that it's not their fault and don't punish them for seeking help.

Normalise their feelings – let them know that it is normal to feel scared, confused or upset.

Don't over-react by taking away the technology – this may make them less likely to talk to you if something else happens. For young children in particular, consider using parental controls to block out specific keywords like Momo.

If you or your child comes across this type of content report it to the platform that it's on. If you know that a young person has been engaging in this challenge, report it to the Police or Netsafe.
