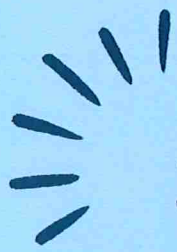
Principal's Pānui

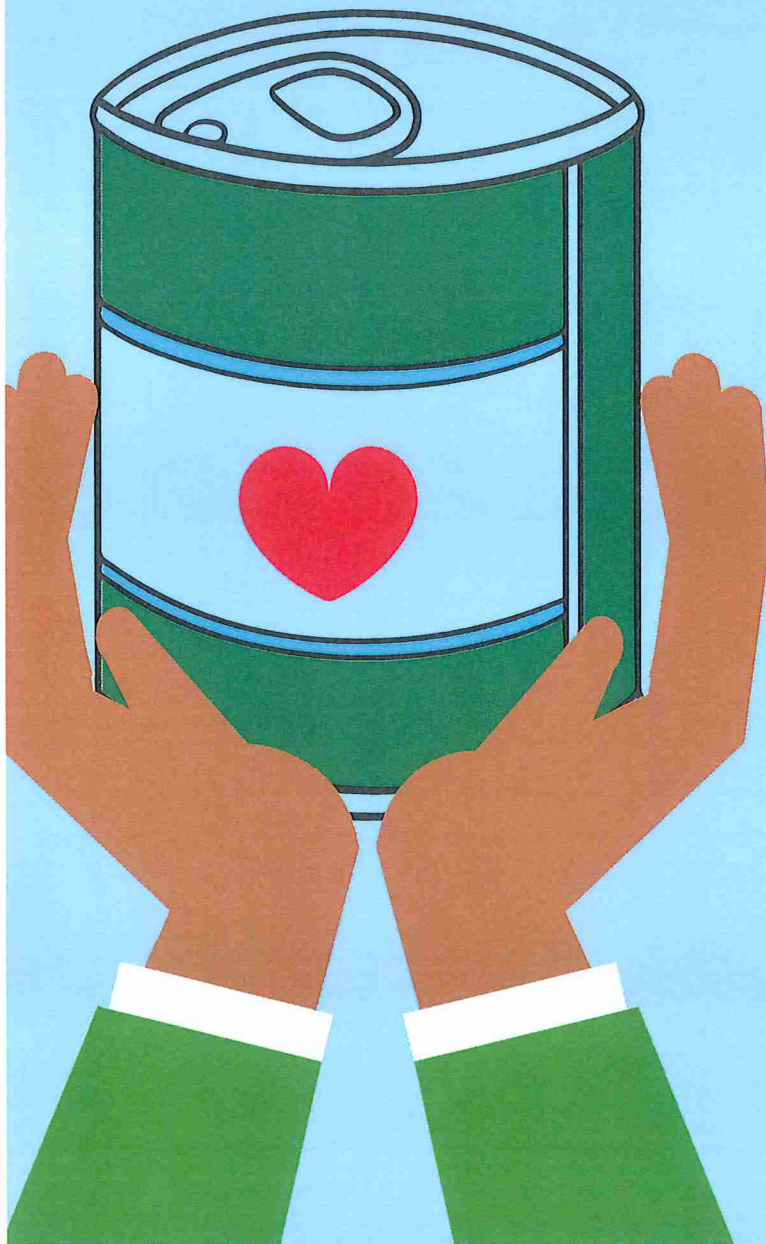
